
Pursuant to paragraph 15 of the Emergency Administrative Order (EAO) issued July 21, 2009, to you as owners and/or operators of the Medicine Bow Lodge, this Addendum to the EAO incorporates the schedule for actions aimed at ensuring compliance with the total coliform maximum contaminant level (MCL), outlined in your fax of August 3, 2009 as revised by your fax of September 2, 2009. This letter constitutes the written approval by EPA of that schedule. Please be advised that you must continue to meet the total coliform rule MCL requirements. If the actions listed in this schedule do not bring the water system into compliance with the total coliform MCL, EPA may require additional actions.

The following schedule lists the actions to be taken as set forth in your August 3, 2009 plan, including revisions of September 2, 2009, and if applicable, the start and completion dates of the actions. EPA recognizes that many of the actions have already been completed and thanks you for your proactive efforts to ensure safe drinking water for guests of the Medicine Bow Lodge.

<u>Action</u>	<u>Begin Date</u>	<u>Completion</u>
Inspect the chlorine system on a weekly basis	August 3, 2009	Ongoing
Take and log chlorine residual samples weekly (sampling site: kitchen). Promptly notify EPA of results.	September 2, 2009	Ongoing
Begin taking TCR samples from women's bathroom in bath house.	August 3, 2009	Until EPA approves kitchen sample site.
Restrict use of bath house by Medicine Bow Lodge "wranglers."	August 3, 2009	Ongoing
Change total coliform sampling site from bath house to kitchen.	September 2, 2009	EPA approved site change September 8, 2009.
Assure proper total coliform sampling techniques, including cleaning/sanitizing faucet, allowing water to run at least five minutes, and removing faucet screen prior to sampling.	September 2, 2009	Ongoing

Please be advised that you are required to comply with all provisions of the EAO. Penalties for failing to comply are set forth in the Order.
