
Dear Mr. Benson:

This letter is to inform you of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) decision to close the above-referenced Findings of Violation and Order for Compliance (Order) issued to Royal Flush Septic Service Inc. on April 21, 2010. The EPA has determined that Royal Flush has complied with the requirements of the Order and therefore is closing the Order at this time.

Please be aware that Royal Flush is still required to comply with the Clean Water Act (Act) and its implementing regulations, specifically the sewage sludge disposal regulations promulgated pursuant to section 405 of the Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1345, and found at 40 C.F.R. Part 305. Future noncompliance may result in additional enforcement action(s) which could include penalties of up to \$37,500 per day per violation.
