MOTION

Informative Motion and Request for Extension of Time to File Executed Consent Agreement and Final Order

COMES NOW Complainant, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) through the undersigned attorney, and respectfully alleges, prays and requests as follows:

On January 7, 2009, attorney for Complainant, Pedro J. Nieves-Miranda, filed a motion informing the Office of Administrative Law Judges, Honorable Barbara A. Gunning, that on January 2, 2009, the Governor of Puerto Rico, Luis G. Fortuño, nominated him as a member of the Governor's cabinet to act as President of the Environmental Quality Board. In that same motion he requested the Honorable Court to remove him as counsel of the record for Complainant in this case. Subsequently the case was reassigned to the undersigned.

Complainant and Respondents Quality Engineers and Contractors, Inc. and Cidra Excavation (together, "the Parties") reached an agreement in principle dispositive of all matters asserted in the Administrative Complaint, including a penalty.

The Parties are engaged in settlement discussions in order to reach an agreement as to the final language and terms of the Consent Agreement and Final Order (CA/FO). Once the CA/FO is finalized it will be placed into concurrence within several EPA officers located in Region 2's San Juan and New York offices for their review and concurrence. Also, in order to file a duly executed CA/FO, the signature of the Respondent and the signature of the Regional Administrator are required. Once this process concludes, the fully executed CA/FO will immediately be filed.

This Motion has been filed today in order to have the Administrative Law Judge, Honorable Barbara A. Gunning, take notice of the agreement reached by the Parties and of the progress made in formalizing this agreement in a fully executed CA/FO. Due to the complexity of the review and concurrence process within the Agency and between the Parties in order to finalize a fully executed CA/FO, the Parties request the Honorable Administrative Law Judge until March 24, 2009, in order to file the duly executed CA/FO and notify its execution to the Presiding Officer.

This Motion was discussed today, February 24, 2009, with Patricio Martínez-Lorenzo, Esq., attorney for the Respondents, who agreed to the filing of this motion. Respectfully submitted, in San Juan, Puerto Rico, this 24th day of February, 2009.
