#### JOINT STATUS REPORT

This Joint Status Report is in response to your Prehearing Order, dated November 25, 2008. During the past four months, the parties in the above-referenced proceeding have participated in Alternative Dispute Resolution ("ADR") with mediator, Judge William Moran. As of the date when ADR expired, on November 12, 2008, the parties reached a settlement in principle, subject to memorialization of the terms and conditions in two separate Consent Agreement/Final Orders ("CA/FOS").

Given that the settlements between Complainant and each Respondent are different with respect to civil penalty and compliance/injunctive measures, and given that one of the settlements involves a Supplemental Environmental Project ("SEP"), the parties believe it will be preferable to enter into two separate settlement documents.

During the past several weeks, Complainant's counsel has been preparing separate draft separate settlement documents, which are presently undergoing review by Complainant's program office. Since these settlements both involve federal facilities, EPA headquarters Federal Facilities Enforcement Office must also review the settlement documents.

Given the different and multiple layers of review, it is expected to take several more weeks before draft CA/FOs are ready to be sent to the Respondents for their review and comment. After Respondents provide feedback on the CA/FOs, the CA/FOs will undergo concurrence in Complainant's office and then an execution copy of the documents will be sent to Respondents for their respective signatures.

JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME REQUESTING THE COURT TO EXTEND THE TIME FOR SUBMITTING PREHEAING EXCHANGES AND ALLOWING SUFFICIENT TIME TO FILE FULLY EXECUTED CA/FO WITH THE COURT

In light of the foregoing, the parties file this motion pursuant to 40 C.F.R. Section 22.16(a), requesting that your Honor extend the prehearing exchanges deadlines for sixty (60) days, until March 12, 2009 (Complainant's Initial Prehearing Exchange), April 17, 2009 (Respondents' Prehearing Exchange) and May 3, 2009 (Complainant's Rebuttal Prehearing Exchange (if necessary)). Complainant's counsel has conferred with Respondents' counsel and they concur in this request for extension. This will allow the parties to focus their attention and resources in getting settlement documents finalized, reviewed and approved by their respective signatories, rather than engage in prehearing discovery at this time.
