This letter is to inform you of the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Emergency Order, Docket Number SDWA-08-2007-0071, issued to the National Park Service, Department of Interior, regarding the Triangle X Ranch on August 21, 2007. This decision is based upon system improvements that resulted in turbidity in the water returning to a safe level.

Please be aware that the Triangle X Ranch is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (NPDWR), 40 C.F.R. Part 141. Violation of the NPDWRs or an administrative order may lead to further enforcement pursuant to section 1447 of the Safe Drinking Water Act.
