This is the third Addendum to the Emergency Administrative Order (Order) issued on March 15, 2019, to the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Crow Agency (BIA Crow Agency), concerning a loss of pressure in the Crow Agency Public Water System. The purpose of this letter is to approve a schedule extension, based on the January 17, 2020 memorandum from the Acting Superintendent of the Crow Indian Agency, for meeting the last deadline in the Order. The revised schedule set forth below is hereby incorporated into the Order per paragraph 18 (page 3) of the Order. The milestone described below is an enforceable provision of the Order.

Finalize the project to include a flow meter.	March 31, 2020

Within 10 calendar days of completing the step included in the above Schedule, please notify the EPA of the project's completion as required by the Order. The EPA is authorized to seek penalties if these deadlines are not met. If BIA Crow Agency has a reasonable basis to believe it may be unable to meet the deadline in the Schedule, it shall notify the EPA, well in advance of the scheduled deadline to request an extension.

As a reminder, you are required to provide the EPA with quarterly progress reports.
