Attached for your review and signature is a Consent Agreement and Final Order ("CAFO") that will resolve a Clean Water Act ("CWA") administrative penalty action brought by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 1 ("EPA") against Catania-Spagna Corporation ("Catania") for an oil spill into navigable waters in the State of Massachusetts.

The Consent Agreement has been signed by the parties and is now presented for the Regional Judicial Officer's signature of the Final Order. No comments were received during the public comment period.

As permitted by 40 C.F.R. §§ 22.13(b) and 22.18(b)(2), the CAFO will both commence and conclude EPA's enforcement action against Catania. The CAFO describes Catania's alleged CWA violation related to an April 2023 peanut oil spill from its facility in Ayer, Massachusetts. Catania has corrected its CWA violation by cleaning up the spill.

Under the CAFO, Catania will pay a settlement penalty of \$47,813 within 10 days of the date this CAFO becomes final. The penalty is consistent with EPA's *Civil Penalty Policy for Section* 311(b)(3) and Section 311(j) of the Clean Water Act (August 1998).

The parties' consent to the use of digital signatures and Respondent's consent to electronic service are included in the CAFO. The parties' service email addresses are included in the CAFO and the Proposed Certificate of Service transmitted to the Regional Hearing Clerk.
