WHEREAS, on April 9, 2019, Complainant, United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 6, filed a Complaint against Respondent alleging violations of the Clean Water Act. On May 8, 2019, Respondent filed an Answer to the Complaint, where it, among other things, requested a hearing to contest the matter. On July 31, 2019, I issued a Scheduling Order, directing the parties to engage in a settlement conference and to file a Consent Agreement and Final Order or motion for extension of time by October 21, 2019. Otherwise, the parties were to engage in prehearing exchange and ultimately participate in the requested hearing.

Complainant has filed an unopposed motion for extension of time as the parties have agreed to settle this matter. While both parties have agreed to the terms of the settlement save for the payment schedule, execution of the final document is delayed due to medical issues concerning Respondent.

It is therefore ORDERED that the Motion be, and hereby is, GRANTED until December 5, 2019. The dates for the prehearing exchanges set forth in the Scheduling Order are also extended by 45 days.
