

On September 10, 1999, Complainant filed a motion to amend the administrative complaint on the grounds that information obtained after the filing of the complaint implicated three other “persons”¹ in the alleged violations that are the subject of this action.² Complainant seeks leave to amend the complaint pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.14(c) to bring these “persons” into the case. The Bohl respondents filed a response indicating they are not opposed to the motion to amend by letter dated September 22, 1999. No other response to Complainant’s motion to amend the complaint has been filed.

Complainant’s motion to amend the Administrative Complaint is **GRANTED**.

¹ The term “person” means an individual, corporation, partnership, association, State, municipality, commission, or political subdivision of a state, or any interstate body. Section 502(5) of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1362(5).
