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

EPA does not waive the authority to pursue any enforcement action by EPA, the State, or Indian tribe or authorized tribal organization where the facility is located or any local agencies for any other past, present or future violation(s) of the underground storage tank requirements or any other violation(s) under any other statute not described in the Enforcement Compliance Order. Also, upon final approval by EPA of this Settlement Agreement, the Owner or Operator waives its right to a public hearing provided by Section 9006 of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, as amended. This Settlement Agreement is binding on the EPA and the Owner or Operator signing below. The Owner or Operator signing below waives any objections to EPA's jurisdiction with respect to the Enforcement Compliance Order and this Settlement Agreement, and consents to EPA's final approval of this Settlement Agreement is effective upon EPA's final approval below. Please sign the attached Settlement Agreement for Southern Maryland Oil Incorporated, 201 Bugeye Square, Prince Frederick, MD 20678. The original Field Citation cited the Facility for failure to test eight line leak detectors annually as required by COMAR 26.10.05.05 (B) and 40 C.F.R. § 280.44 - (a). The facility tested eight line leak detectors 169 days after the required testing date.

Since issuance of the Field Citation the facility has provided a check to the U. S. Treasury and the facility is in compliance with UST regulations.

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
