1. An Initial Prehearing Order was issued by Chief Administrative Law Judge, Susan L. Biro, requiring the Parties in this matter to file a fully executed Consent Agreement and Final Order (“CAFO”) memorializing the settlement of this matter by March 1, 2013 and contemporaneously send a copy to the Office of Administrative Law Judges.

2. Both BioSensory Inc. (“Respondent”) and Complainant have signed and executed the CAFO.
