Based upon the information provided in your June 19, 2013 Supplemental Environmental Project ("SEP") submittal, you have satisfactorily completed the Environmental Restoration and Protection SEP in accordance with the Consent Agreement and Final Order, Docket No. CWA-02-2010-3403. Dolomite documented completion of its land conservation SEP, valued at \$90,000, which include the following: donating 21 acres of open space (valued at \$63,000), designated and deeded as Forever Wild to the Town of Gates; purchasing an additional 1 acre of land (valued at \$12,000) also donated and conserved as Forever Wild by the Town of Gates; and providing \$15,000 to the Town of Gates for management and monitoring of the SEP (collectively referred to as the "Forever Wild Project").

With the completion of the SEP and prior payment of the required \$20,000 penalty, Dolomite Products Co., Inc. has fulfilled its obligations under this Consent Agreement and Final Order.
