WHEREAS, on or about August 13, 1998, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Respondent signed issued the Administrative Order on Consent for Implementation of Non-Time Critical Removal Action, Docket No. CERCLA VIII-98-15 (AOC), pertaining to the Pallas Yard Superfund Site (Site);

WHEREAS, the AOC requires Respondent to perform certain work as specified in the AOC and its attached statement of work;

WHEREAS, Respondent has completed all required work under the AOC and made the final response cost payment for Fiscal Year 2024;

THEREFORE, the AOC is closed.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the EPA reserves and the termination of the AOC is without prejudice to, the right to issue an administrative order or to institute proceedings in this action or in a new action seeking to compel Respondent to perform further response actions relating to the Site, to reimburse EPA for additional costs of response, or any combination thereof.
