## JOINT MOTION TO CONFORM TRANSCRIPT

Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 164.82 and the Presiding Officer's February 6, 2023, order, Respondent Office of Pesticide Programs ("OPP"), Petitioner AMVAC Chemical Corporation ("AMVAC"), and the Grower-Shipper Association of Central California; J&D Produce; Ratto Bros., Inc.; and Huntington Farms (the "Grower Petitioners," and, together with OPP and AMVAC, the "Parties") hereby jointly move to conform the transcript of the hearing to the actual testimony presented at the hearing and for related relief as set forth below.

The administrative hearing in the above-captioned matter was held from January 24 through January 25, 2023, in Washington, DC. The Parties received the initial transcript of the testimony taken at the hearing on February 6, 2023. The Parties state that the initial transcript contains typographical and transcription errors and agree that making the specified changes is necessary to ensure that the transcript is accurate and the record is complete. The Parties jointly move for the following relief:

First, that the Presiding Officer accept and adopt the corrections jointly proposed in documentation separately provided to the OALJ and direct the Court Reporter to revise the transcript accordingly or otherwise certify the document(s) comprising the final transcript pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 164.82.<sup>1</sup>

Second, the Parties believe that a portion of on-the-record discussion is omitted from the draft transcript which occurred between lines three and four of page 204 (Jan. 24) of the draft. The Parties request that the Presiding Officer confirm with the Court Reporter whether there is any record of statements made between the ones currently transcribed on those lines.

Third, the Parties request that the Presiding Officer confirm that the record contains all JX, RX, PAX, and PGX Exhibits as identified in Exhibit A to the Parties' January 31, 2023, Joint Status Report (Dkt. 54) and ensure that the documents comprising the final transcript pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 164.82 reflect this.
