

ORDER GRANTING SECOND EXTENSION OF ALTERNATIVE
DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The parties have represented that while a Consent Agreement and Final Order (CAFO) has not yet been filed, they have made substantial progress toward final resolution of this matter. Finalization of a Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP) has required phone conferences with the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection. Now that SEP-related issues have been resolved, a proposed CAFO has allegedly been submitted to Respondent for review. For good cause shown, the Alternative Dispute Resolution Process, which expired on January 1, 2010, is extended for a final 30 days through February 1, 2010.


