

REPORT RECOMMENDING TERMINATION  
OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS  
AND ASSIGNMENT OF A JUDGE FOR LITIGATION

The Report of September 3, 2015 provides that this alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process terminates October 5, 2015. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be terminated, and that the case be assigned to a Judge for resolution through litigation.

The parties in this matter have not reached a final agreement to settle this matter. The parties, however, did successfully use the ADR process to negotiate the framework for a possible settlement. They are encouraged to continue their negotiations to try to conclude a settlement agreement.

Finally, the undersigned expresses her appreciation to the parties for the courtesy and candor with which they participated in the ADR process. Accordingly, the case should now be assigned to a Judge to preside over a litigated resolution of this case.
