ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

By Motion dated June 24, 2010, Complainant moved for an extension of time to engage in the prehearing exchange. The Motion indicated that the Respondent had no objection to the extension requested.

Good cause exists for the granting of the Motion. The Motion indicates that Complainant's counsel and its technical representative whose assistance Complainant requires to properly prepare its prehearing exchange are unavailable for periods immediately preceding the current filing date for the prehearing exchange. In that a hearing in this case has yet to be scheduled, no prejudice will result from a brief delay in the prehearing exchange process. Therefore, the Complainant shall have until **July 30, 2010** to submit its initial prehearing exchange; Respondent shall have until **August 16, 2010** to submit its prehearing exchange; and Complainant shall have until **August 31, 2010** to submit its rebuttal prehearing exchange.




