

REPORT RECOMMENDING CONTINUATION
OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The Report approved May 24, 2016 provides that this alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process terminates July 15, 2016. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be continued for a *final* month, to August 15, 2016.

This continuation of the ADR process is recommended because the parties have agreed to settle this matter, but additional time is needed for the execution of the Consent Agreement and Final Order ("CAFO"). Accordingly, the undersigned will continue to work as a Neutral in this case and will file another report with the Chief Administrative Law Judge by August 15, 2016 unless otherwise directed by her. The parties are commended for their success in negotiating their agreement.
