ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYMENT OF LISA M. CASTELLANO AND THE LAW FIRM OF GENOVESE JOBLOVE & BATTISTA, P.A. <u>AS COUNSEL TO CHAPTER 7 TRUSTEE (Doc. 4)</u>

THIS CASE came before the Court without a hearing upon the *Application for Entry of* an Order Authorizing the Employment of Lisa M. Castellano and the Law Firm of Genovese Joblove & Battista, P.A. as Counsel to Chapter 7 Trustee (Doc. 4) (the "Employment <u>Application</u>"). The Trustee seeks to employ Lisa M. Castellano and the law firm of Genovese Joblove & Battista, P.A. (collectively, "<u>GJB</u>") as the Trustee's General Counsel to provide the services set forth in paragraph 8 of the Employment Application. The Court, having considered the Employment Application and supporting Declaration, noting the GJB attorneys are duly admitted to practice before this court, finding that the employment is necessary and it would be in the best interest of the Debtor's estate, entry of this order is necessary to avoid immediate and

irreparable harm¹, and determining that a hearing is not required on the Employment Application, does hereby

ORDER as follows:

1. The Employment Application is APPROVED.

2. None of the disclosures or representations set forth in the Declaration of Lisa M. Castellano in support of the Employment Application constitutes a conflict of interest or impairs the disinterestedness of GJB or otherwise precludes the Trustee's employment of Ms. Castellano and GJB in this case.

3. The Trustee is authorized to employ Ms. Castellano and GJB as his General Counsel in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Employment Application.

4. GJB is authorized to render professional services to the Trustee as described in the Employment Application.

5. GJB shall apply for compensation for professional services rendered and reimbursement of expenses incurred in connection with the Debtor's case in compliance with the applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rules, Local Rules, guidelines established by the Office of the United States Trustee for the Middle District of Florida and any other applicable procedures and orders of the Court.

Compensation will be determined at a later date in accordance with 11 U.S.C. §
330.
