ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

By Order dated August 7, 2020, the parties were instructed to file their fully executed Partial Consent Agreement/Final Order (“CA/FO”) with the Regional Hearing Clerk by October 2, 2020. *See* Order Establishing Filing Deadlines (“Order”) at 2. The parties were ordered to submit a courtesy copy of the fully executed Partial CA/FO to the Tribunal by that date as well. Order at 2. The Order also established a deadline of October 16, 2020 by which the parties were required to file a Joint Proposed Plan with the Tribunal. Order at 2.


On October 1, 2020, the parties filed a Joint Motion for Extension of Time (“Motion”), requesting that the Tribunal move the deadline for filing the fully executed Partial CA/FO to October 16, 2020. Mot. at 1. The parties state that they “have agreed on the terms of a Partial CAFO and are currently in the process of executing that document.” Mot. at 1. The parties assert that they “jointly seek a two-week extension” because “the final execution—signatures, payments, etc.—can take several days to finalize[.]” Mot. at 1. The parties do not request an extension of time for filing the Joint Proposed Plan. Mot. at 1.

Under the Consolidated Rules of Practice governing this proceeding, set forth at 40 C.F.R. Part 22, I “may grant an extension of time for filing any document: upon timely motion of a party to the proceeding, for good cause shown, and after consideration of prejudice to other parties[.]” 40 C.F.R. § 22.7(b). I find that good cause exists to allow the jointly requested extension of time. The Motion is **GRANTED**. The new deadlines are set out as follows:

The fully executed Partial CA/FO is due to the Regional Hearing Clerk on or before **Friday, October 16, 2020**.

A courtesy copy of the fully executed Partial CA/FO and the Joint Proposed Plan shall be filed with the Tribunal on or before **Friday, October 16, 2020**.
