ORDER ON MOTION TO EXTEND PREHEARING EXCHANGE DEADLINE

On July 5, 2016, I issued an order setting the deadlines for the parties to conduct their prehearing exchanges. That order set a deadline of September 16, 2016 for the Complainant to submit its rebuttal prehearing exchange. On August 1, 2016, the Complainant filed a motion requesting a two-week extension of this deadline (“Motion”). The Complainant requests this extension because its counsel will be out of the country during the two weeks immediately preceding the current deadline. Motion at 1. The Motion states that opposing counsel does not oppose the extension. *Id.*

The Rules of Practice governing this proceeding provide that “the Presiding Officer may grant an extension of time for filing any document: upon timely motion of a party to the proceeding, for good cause shown, and after consideration of prejudice to other parties[.]” 40 C.F.R. § 22.7(b). As a timely motion showing good cause has been filed and the Respondents do not oppose the Motion, the requested extension is hereby **GRANTED**.

The new deadline for Complainant to submit its rebuttal prehearing exchange shall be **September 30, 2016**.


