MOTION FOR WITNESS SUBPOENA

- 1. Part 61, Subpart M, as well as the appropriateness and amount of civil penalties to be assessed against the Respondent.
- 2. At all times relevant to the violations alleged in this matter, James A. Weltz was employed at Criterion Laboratories, Inc. ("Criterion"). Mr. Weltz was the laboratory director at the time samples collected by EPA Inspector Ponak, from the August 27, 2013 inspection of the demolished 896 3rd Street, Whitehall, PA facility, were analyzed by Criterion. possesses information that is relevant and material to the issue of Respondent's liability for the violations alleged in the Complaint, and to the gravity of those alleged violations.

- 4. Clean Air Act Section 307(a) authorizes the issuance of subpoenas for the attendance and testimony of witnesses in administrative enforcement proceedings.

WHEREFORE: Complainant respectfully requests that the Presiding Officer issue a subpoena for the attendance and testimony at the hearing scheduled in this matter of James A. Weltz for which EPA will pay appropriate fees and mileage.
