
**UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE OPENING PREHEARING EXCHANGES**

COMES NOW Complainant and, in response to the request of the Presiding Officer, files this Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time in which to file opening Prehearing Exchanges. Pursuant to the Order Setting Prehearing Procedures (Order) issued by the Presiding Officer on December 9, 2014, the Complainant and Respondent (Parties) are instructed to file opening Prehearing Exchanges no later than January 30, 2015. In addition, the Order set forth a prehearing filing schedule, as authorized by Section 22.19 of the Consolidated Rules of Practice Governing the Administrative Assessment of Civil Penalties and the Revocation or Suspension of Permits.

Complainant filed an Administrative Complaint alleging violations of the Clean Water Act (CWA) and associated National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) against Respondent on June 16, 2014. The Respondent submitted its Answer to the Complaint on July 16, 2014. Pursuant to the December 9, 2014 Pretrial Order, on December 18, 2014 the Parties sought to reach settlement pursuant to 40 CFR § 22.18(b) to resolve this matter. The CWA Enforcement Program, EPA Region 6 (Program) reached an agreement to settle the case with Respondent. Both parties need additional time to prepare and review the settlement
