Complainant U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") hereby respectfully submits the following Motion for Extension of Time to File Dispositive Motions Regarding Liability.

1. On March 20, 2024, this Court ordered that dispositive motions regarding liability, such as a motion for accelerated decision or motion to dismiss under Section 22.20(a) of the Rules of Practice, must be filed within thirty (30) days after the due date for Complainant's Rebuttal Prehearing Exchange.
2. Here, Complainant's Rebuttal Prehearing Exchange was due on June 7, 2024. Therefore, dispositive motions are due by July 7, 2024.
3. On June 21, 2024, Complainant filed a Motion for Additional Discovery seeking ability to pay information from Respondent.
4. This Court has not yet ruled on Complainant's Motion for Additional Discovery filed June 21, 2024.
5. To allow for time for this Court to rule on Complainant's Motion for Additional Discovery, and to allow time for Complainant to incorporate any such ruling in possible dispositive motions, Complainant requests that the deadline for

dispositive motions be extended sixty (60) days, to September 5, 2024.

6. Complainant communicated its intention to file this motion to Respondent and Respondent did not provide a response.
