- 2. Whether Respondent applied Delaro and Bifen in accordance with their registered labels.
- 3. Whether the chemicals were sprayed in a way that violated applicable rules, regulations, statutes, or code sections.

WHEREFORE, having fully answered the Complainant's Complaint, Respondent prays that this Court dismiss Complainant's Complaint and that Respondent recovers its costs incurred herein.
