Sites Proposed for Early Cleanup

The Lower Duwamish Waterway Group (King County, City of Seattle, Port of Seattle, and The Boeing Company) will tell you about their study of the waterway:

- ★ Nature and extent of chemical contamination in the waterway sediments.
- ★ Their assessment of the risks to people and wildlife from that contamination.
- ★ Their proposed sites for early sediment cleanup.

There will also be an opportunity to ask EPA, Ecology, and the Lower Duwamish Waterway Group questions about the study.

To get early public input, EPA and Ecology are making three draft reports by the Lower Duwamish Waterway Group available to the public at the same time that the agencies review them:
