COMPLIANCE SCHEDULE

Pursuant to the South Dakota Air Pollution Control Regulations, 1.13, all new installations shall be in compliance, when they go into operation, with South Dakota's Air Pollution Control Regulations. A sixty (60) day grace period will be granted to confirm new source compliance. With one exception, all existing sources not in compliance as of the effective date of the Air Pollution Control Regulations shall be in compliance within one year of the effective date of the Air Pollution Control Regulations. All existing forest products industry sources not in compliance as of the effective date of the Air Pollution Control Regulations shall be in compliance within eighteen (18) months of the effective date of the Air Pollution Control Regulations. Any existing source which cannot be in compliance within the period specified by these Regulations is required to request a variance in accord with Section 1.6. This variance request shall include a time table and plan for compliance for the Commission's consideration. The Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency will be advised of all variances granted the next subsequent semiannual report.
