

ORDINANCE NO. 01-97

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ENHANCED
VEHICLE EMISSIONS INSPECTION
MAINTENANCE PROGRAM ORDINANCE DATED
OCTOBER 9, 1996.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Davis County as follows:

Section 1. Section 6.1.1 of the Enhanced Vehicle Emissions Inspection.

Maintenance Program Ordinance compiled in book form and bearing the date of October 9, 1996, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6.1.1 Beginning January 1, 1998, all 1968 and newer model year vehicles shall be subject to an enhanced I/M inspection. Vehicles that are six, nine, and twelve model-years old or any combination of vehicles which provide emission reductions which are equal to or greater than vehicles which are six, nine, and twelve model-years old are required to be tested at the County operated enhanced I/M Program Station. All vehicles not subject to testing at the County-run IM240 facility are required to be tested annually at an enhanced Basic I/M Program Station.

Section 2. Section 6.1.2 of the Enhanced Vehicle Emissions Inspection


Maintenance Program Ordinance compiled in book form and bearing the date of October 9, 1996, is hereby deleted. As a result of the deletion, the current numbering of Sections should be changed so that Section 6.1.3 is now numbered 6.1.2 and 6.1.4 is hereby numbered as 6.1.3.

Section 3. All provisions of the Enhanced Vehicle Emissions Inspection

Maintenance Program Ordinance compiled in book form and bearing the date of October 9, 1996, are reaffirmed except as modified by this Ordinance.
