

SOURCE SURVEILLANCE.

Pursuant to Section 1.10 of the South Dakota Air Pollution Control Regulations, sources may be required to maintain records and periodically report to the State information necessary to determine whether such sources are in compliance with the control strategy. Periodic renewal of the permit to operate will be used to keep the surveillance system data up to date. Point sources will be inspected every two years, with complaint investigations as needed. The visible emissions regulations and inspection of control equipment and operating conditions will be used to detect violations. The State and local agencies will conduct source surveillance throughout the State.
