

XI. Reports and Revisions

A. In compliance with the requirements of Section 420.7 of the August 14, 1971, Federal Register, quarterly air quality summary reports and semi annual reports will be prepared and submitted through the designated office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

B. This plan will be revised whenever deemed necessary in accordance with the requirements of Section 420.6 of the August 14, 1971, Federal Register.

Implementation Plan Reviews

The following provision pertaining to a periodic review of the SIP is adopted into the control strategy chapter of the State Implementation Plan.

The Ambient Air Quality in the various areas of the State will be reviewed on a periodic basis (depending upon the rate of industrial, general, and air quality emission growth in such area) to determine the compliance status of such air quality with respect to Ambient Air Quality Standards and allowable increments under the regulations for the prevention of significant deterioration.

If any area is determined to be in non-compliance with respect to any such requirement, notification to the public will be issued within 60 days of non-compliance determination and a corrective program will be defined and implemented.

The air quality in each area of the state will be reviewed at least every five years for purposes of determining compliance.
