This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is proposing a minor revision to the Major Facility Review Permit for U.S. Pipe and Foundry Company (Facility Number A0083) based on Applications #22124 and #26510 and is submitting the permit to EPA for review.

The following revisions have been made to the permit:

- The facility contact has been changed to reflect personnel changes.
- The part IV and part VII tables have been amended to reflect the additional requirements that apply to S-33 Gasoline Dispensing Facility as a result of the replacement of its storage tank and associated vapor recovery systems.
- The part IV and part VII tables have been amended to reflect the permitting of S-42 and S-43 Cold Cleaners. S-42 and S-43 are existing sources that have lost an exemption. Therefore, their addition has no affect on facility emission rates.
- The test methods table has been amended to reflect the additional test method that applies to S-33 as a result of its modification.
- Corrections have been made to the citation of Condition 13321 for Source S-41, Portable Abrasive Blasting Units #2 by adding a separate table for S-41 in Sections IV and VII, and renumbering the condition.
- The permit has been amended to delete outdated SIP requirements, revise the dates of rule adoptions, and correct the citations of BAAQMD Regulation 6 in Section VII.
