This is an existing facility applying for a Title V permit renewal that is engaged in the business of aerospace coating. The facility operates spray booths, ovens, an aluminum etch line, a passivation line, a sulfuric acid anodizing line, a chromic acid anodizing line, abrasive blasting equipment, air pollution control equipment baghouses, a scrubber, and HEPA filters, and other supporting equipment.

Pursuant to Title V of the federal Clean Air Act and SCAQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance unless such permit has been renewed. Accordingly, each of the above facilities has submitted a Title V renewal application and requested the SCAQMD

to renew their Title V permit. Each of the proposed permits incorporates updates to the facility information provided in the facility's Title V renewal application and all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to the facility.

The proposed permits are available for public review at the SCAQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765 and at the Los Angeles Public Library, Science, Technology, and Patents Department, 630 West 5th Street, Los Angeles, CA 90071. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the SCAQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the SCAQMD based on credible information, is also available from the SCAQMD for public review. Comments must be received by July 9, 2013. The SCAQMD will consider all public comments and may revise the Title V permit in accordance with SCAQMD rules and regulations.

The public may request the SCAQMD to conduct a public hearing on any of the proposed permits by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Hamed Mandilawi at the above SCAQMD address. The SCAQMD will hold a public hearing if there is evidence that the proposed permits are not correct or are not adequate to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements, and a hearing will likely provide additional information that will affect the drafting and/or issuance of the permits.
