Enclosed, please find the revisions for the Title Page, Table of Contents, Section D and Section H of your Title V Facility Permit. The revised sections reflect the approval of a De Minimus Significant revision of the Title V Permit. The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) issued a draft permit for Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) review on September 24, 2010 and no comments were received from the EPA. No Public Notice was required for a De Minimus Significant revision. Changes to your Title V permit are as follows:

Changed condition No. 10 to allow the use of up to 10% natural gas on a monthly basis, No. 11 and 12 to allow using natural gas in the pre combustion chamber and No. 21 to include the NOx and NMOC limit based on an approved Emission Correction Factor, provided by Rule 1110.2.
