The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) has received and reviewed a Title V application for a Significant Revision to the ExxonMobil Refinery Facility Permit. ExxonMobil is proposing to install a new emergency fire pump internal combustion engine (ICE). The new equipment is subject to 40 CFR 60, Subpart IIII and 40 CFR 63, Subpart ZZZZ; therefore, the revision is a significant revision and is subject to a 45-day EPA review (AQMD Rule 3003) and a 30-day public notice period (AQMD Rule 3006). The IC engine is listed in the table below.

The AQMD is required under Rule 3005(i) to provide a copy of the proposed permit to the EPA administrator for a 45-day review.
