NOTICE OF PROPOSED REVISION TO TITLE V PERMIT

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is the air pollution control agency for the four county-region including all of Orange County and non-desert portions of Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties. Rule 3006 requires that the AQMD publish this notice prior to a significant revision to a Title V permit.

This is an existing facility applying to modify their Title V permit. The facility is a petroleum refinery which processes crude oil into products such as gasoline, diesel, jet fuel and other petroleum related products.

The project consists of the installation and operation of one new, 323 brake horsepower, diesel-fueled, internal combustion engine driving an emergency fire pump at the refinery. The equipment will meet the best available technology standards for controlling air pollution. Our calculations show that, based on a 30-day average, a daily maximum emissions of 0.3 pounds of Nitrogen Oxides, 0.14 pounds of Carbon Monoxide, 0.01 pounds of Volatile Organic Compounds, 0.01 pounds of Sulfur Oxides and 0.01 pounds of Particulate Matter may be emitted from the engine.

As required by Title V of the federal Clean Air Act, the Title V permit includes all the emission limits and operating conditions imposed on the equipment. The facility is required to certify compliance with the Title V permit in addition to recordkeeping and mandatory reporting of any deviation of the permit conditions. Comments must be received by July 11, 2012. The AQMD will consider all public comments and may revise the Title V permit in accordance with AQMD rules and regulations.

The public may request AQMD to conduct a public hearing on the proposed Title V permit by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Jay Chen at the above AQMD address. The public hearing request must contain all the information requested on the form in order for the AQMD to determine whether the request is valid and if a public hearing will be held. Any request for a public hearing must be submitted to the AQMD by June 26, 2012.
