Enclosed please find the revised Title page, Table of Contents, Section D and Section H of your Title V Facility Permit. The revised sections reflect the approval of a De Minimis Significant Permit Revision of the Title V permit. The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) issued a draft permit for Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) review on January 14, 2011, and no comments were received from the EPA. No Public Notice was requirement for the Revision.

504502	ICE (50-500 HP) NON-EMERGENCY STATIONARY NAT GAS FIRED ONLY	Alteration of the natural gas fired ICE to allow the ICE to be vented to the NOx control system under A/N 504398.
