## NOTICE OF PROPOSED REVISION TO TITLE V PERMIT

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is the air pollution control agency for the four county-region including all of Orange County and non-desert portions of Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties. Rule 3006 requires that the AQMD publish this public notice prior to a significant revision to a Title V permit.

### Facility Name & Location

#### **Kinder Morgan Liquid Terminals, LLC (Carson)**

This is an existing facility applying to modify their Title V permit. Kinder Morgan Liquid Terminals, LLC (Carson) is a bulk terminal that stores and transfers petroleum products including gasoline, ethanol, jet fuels, and diesel fuels. This facility operates a number of storage tanks and loading racks as well as vapor recovery systems.

The above facility is proposing to install one storage tank at their facility. The tank will be used to store petroleum products such as gasoline, ethanol, jet fuel or diesel fuel. Additionally, a plan for a Continuous Monitoring System, as required by Rule 462, will also be issued to amend an existing plan.

The maximum daily emissions increase from this project will not exceed 7 pounds of volatile organic compounds (VOCs). The new tank is also subject to federal air quality regulations including 40CFR60 Subpart K<sub>b</sub>, 40CFR63 Subpart R, and 40CFR63 Subpart EEEE, which require public notice prior to permit issuance.

As required by Title V of the federal Clean Air Act, the Title V permit includes all the emission limits and operating conditions imposed on the equipment. The facility are required to certify compliance with the Title V permit in addition to recordkeeping and mandatory reporting of any deviation of the permit conditions. The

proposed permit is available for public review at AQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the AQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the AQMD based on credible information, is also available from the AQMD for public review. Comments must be received by May 4, 2012. The AQMD will consider all public comments and may revise the Title V permit in accordance with AQMD rules and regulations.

The public may request AQMD to conduct a public hearing on the proposed Title V permit by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Jay Chen at the above AQMD address. The public hearing request must contain all the information requested on the form in order for the AQMD to determine whether the request is valid and if a public hearing will be held. Any request for a public hearing must be submitted to the AQMD by April 19, 2012.
