

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED
TITLE V RENEWAL PERMIT**

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is proposing to renew the existing Title V permit previously issued to the facility listed below:

The AQMD is the air pollution control agency for the four county-region including all of Orange County and non-desert portions of Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino counties. Anyone wishing to install or modify equipment that could release or control air pollution within this region must first obtain a permit from the AQMD. This is an existing facility applying for a Title V permit renewal that is engaged in the manufacturing of asphalt and asphalt roofing products. The facility operates conveyors, silos, asphalt tanks, bin hoppers, bucket elevators, knock out pots, loading arms, packaging machines, stills, mixing tanks, boiler, heaters, asphalt roofing machines, coating/sealant applicators, cooling towers, one emergency internal combustion engine, air control equipment including cyclone, filters, afterburners, baghouses and other supporting equipment.

Pursuant to Title V of the federal Clean Air Act and the AQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance unless such permit has been renewed. Accordingly, this facility has submitted a Title V renewal application and requested the AQMD to renew their Title V permit. The proposed permit incorporates updates to the facility information provided in the facility's Title V renewal application and all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to this facility.

The AQMD has evaluated the permit application and has determined that the equipment will meet the requirements of all applicable air quality Rules and Regulations. The AQMD intends to issue this Title V renewal permit. As required by Title V of the federal Clean Air Act, the Title V permits include all of the emission limits, applicable requirements and operating conditions imposed on the equipment. The facilities are required to certify compliance with the Title V permits in addition to recordkeeping and mandatory reporting of any deviation from the permit conditions.

The proposed permit is available for public review at AQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765 and at the Compton Public Library, 240W. Compton Blvd., Compton, CA 90220. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the AQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the AQMD based on credible information, is also available from the AQMD for public review. Comments must be received by October 31, 2010. The AQMD will consider all public comments and may revise the Title V permit in accordance with AQMD rules and regulations.

The public may request AQMD to conduct a public hearing on the proposed permit by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Merrill Hickman at the above AQMD address. The AQMD will hold a public hearing if there is evidence that the proposed permit is not correct or is not adequate to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements, and a hearing will likely provide additional information that will affect the drafting and/or issuance of the permit. Requests for a public hearing are due by October 16, 2010. A copy of the hearing request must also be sent by first class mail to the facility contact person listed above at the same time.
