Enclosed for your 45-day review is the proposed revision to the Title V facility permit for BP West Coast Products LLC (BP) located at 2350 E. 223rd Street, Carson, California. The proposed revision is a De Minimis Significant Revision and a public notice is not required.

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) has received two applications for Permits to Construct and one application for Permit to Operate from BP for the equipment described in tables below. The AQMD has evaluated the applications and has made a preliminary determination that the equipment will operate in compliance with all of the applicable requirements of our rules and regulations.
