Proposed De Minimus Revision to Title V Permit for Equilon Enterprises LLC dba Shell Oil Products US (ID# 117560)

Enclosed for your 45-day review is the proposed revision to the Title V Permit for Equilon Enterprises LLC dba Shell Oil Products US, located at Berth 167-169, Wilmington, CA. This revision is considered a "de minimus permit revision", and a public notice is not required. We are enclosing the revised permits as shown below and the engineering evaluation.

Equipment	New/Previous Application Nos.	Description
Storage Tank M28	479011	Make operable a 9,593 barrel crude oil fixed roof storage tank in order to collect diesel product drained (pumped) from the pipeline after each loading/unloading event
Marine Terminal	479015/345996	Reduce the number of fugitive components associated with manifold piping and adding passive carbon adsorbers for repacking the manifold lines with product.

The initial Title V permit for this facility was issued April 20, 2009. Since then, the facility has filed an application as described above. There will be a slight increase in emissions (less than 0.5 lbs/day) from the storage tank, however the overall proposed project will result in a decrease of emissions of 1.35 pounds per day of VOC. This revision is covered under Application No. 500997.
