NOTICE OF PROPOSED TITLE V RENEWAL PERMIT

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is proposing to renew the existing Title V permit that was previously issued to the following facility:

This is an existing facility applying for a renewal to their Title V permit. The facility processes recycled polystyrene foam products into polystyrene foam packaging materials (loose fills). Free Flow currently operates one polystyrene foam packaging manufacturing system, two boilers and one blowing agent storage tank. The polystyrene foam packaging manufacturing system consists of two extruders, three expanders, product and intermediate product storage rooms, and associated conveyors and hoppers. The VOC emissions from the polystyrene foam packaging manufacturing system are being controlled by a regenerative thermal oxidizer.

Pursuant to Title V of the Federal Clean Air Act and AQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance unless such permit has been renewed. Accordingly, the above facility has submitted a Title V renewal application and requested the AQMD to renew their Title V permit. The proposed permit incorporates updates to the facility information provided in the facility's Title V renewal application and all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to the facility.

The proposed permit is available for public review at AQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765 and Bell Gardens Library at 7110 S. Garfield Avenue, Bell Gardens, CA 90201. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the AQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the AQMD based on credible information, is also available from the AQMD for public review. Comments must be received by July 5, 2011. The AQMD will consider all public comments and may revise the Title V permit in accordance with AQMD rules and regulations.

The public may request AQMD to conduct a public hearing on the proposed permit by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Stephen Jiang at the above AQMD address. The AQMD will hold a public hearing if there is evidence that the proposed permit is not correct or is not adequate to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements, and a hearing will likely provide additional information that will affect the drafting and/or issuance of the permit.
