NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF TITLE V PERMIT

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is the air pollution control agency for all of Orange County and portions of Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties. This is to inform the public of the intention of the AQMD to renew the existing Title V permit previously issued to the facility listed below.

This facility operates a resource recovery landfill gas to energy (LFGTE) plant to generate about 24 MW power for sale to the grid. Permitted equipment consists of landfill gas treatment system, internal combustion engines, ammonia storage tank, landfill gas combustion turbines and enclosed landfill gas flares.

Pursuant to Title V of the federal Clean Air Act and AQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance, unless such permit has been renewed. Accordingly, the above facility has submitted a Title V renewal application and requested the AQMD to renew their Title V permit. The proposed permit incorporates updates to the facility information, as provided in the facility's Title V renewal application, and all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to the facility.

The proposed permit is available for public review at AQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765, and at Brea Branch Library, 1, Civic Center Circle, Brea, CA 92821. The proposed permit can also be viewed at <http://www3.aqmd.gov/webappl/publicnotices2/>

The public hearing request must contain all the information requested on the form in order for the AQMD to determine whether or not the request is valid or if a public hearing will be held.
