Dear Mr. Rios:

Enclosed for your 45-day review is the proposed revision to the Title V Permit for LA County Sanitation Districts (Palos Verdes), located at 26301 Crenshaw Blvd., Rolling Hills, CA 90274. This revision is considered to be a significant revision and a public notice is required. In addition, pursuant to AQMD Rule 212 - Standards for Approving Permits, subdivision (c)(2), new or modified sources exceeding any of the specified daily maximums are subject to the public notification and comment provisions of 40 CFR Part 51, Section 51.161(b), and 40 CFR Part 124, Section 124.10. The AQMD has evaluated this application and made a preliminary determination that the equipment will operate in compliance with all of the applicable requirements of our Rules and Regulations.

We are enclosing proposed Section H, including the revised permit as shown below, the engineering evaluation and a copy of the public notice in accordance with both Rules 3006 and Rule 212(g). The public notice provides for a 30 day comment period prior to making a final decision on the issuance of permits, and is also being published in a newspaper of general circulation in the vicinity of the nearest affected areas. This notice is being sent to the City of Rolling Hills, Los Angeles County, California Air Resources Board, U.S. EPA, the Southern California Association of Governments and the State and Federal Land Managers.
