B. PURPOSE OF THIS STATEMENT OF BASIS:

The Title V Federal Operating Permit is intended to be a document containing only enforceable terms and conditions as well as any additional information, such as the identification of emission units, emission points, emission sources and processes, that makes the terms meaningful. 40 CFR Part 70.7(a)(5) requires that each Title V permit have an accompanying "...statement that sets forth the legal and factual basis for the draft permit conditions". The purpose of this Statement of Basis is to satisfy the above requirement by providing pertinent details regarding the permit/application data and permit conditions in a more easily understandable format. This report will also include background narrative and explanations of regulatory decisions made by the reviewer. It should be emphasized that this Statement of Basis, while based on information contained in the permit, is a separate document and is not itself an enforceable term and condition of the permit.

In addition to this Statement of Basis the information contained in the Statement of Basis for the 03-01-2009 Title V permit renewal and the 09-15-2009 Title V permit significant modification is applicable to the facility.

C. ADMINISTRATIVE PERMIT AMENDMENT DESCRIPTION:

Requested Amendment

In a permit application, dated August 17, 2009, SPA Cogeneration Project requested that the Contact Person listed in Title V Permit No. TV2007-14-02 be changed:

from: Kurt Hook, Facility Manager

to: Dave Blevins, Facility Manager

The request qualifies as an administrative permit amendment because a name change of a person identified in the Title V permit is listed as one of the qualifying actions in the definition of "Administrative Title V Permit Amendment" in SMAQMD Rule 207 Section 202.2.

This administrative permit amendment is made pursuant to SMAQMD Rule 207 Section 409.

Public Notice

SMAQMD Rule 207 Section 409 states that no public notice is required for a Title V administrative permit amendment.

Permit Distribution

The revised Title V Permit No. TV2007-14-02A will be provided to the permittee and to U.S. EPA Region IX.

Revised Permit Numbering

The new Title V permit number for the amended permit will be Title V Permit No. TV2007-14-02A.

The adding of sequential alphabetic letters to the current permit number (beginning with A for the first administrative amendment) indicates an administrative permit amendment.

Recommendation

Re-issue Title V Permit No. TV2007-14-02A with the administrative permit amendment.
