A draft permit for the changes to the storage tanks was issued for EPA's 45-day review on April 6, 2011. A public notice was published in a newspaper on April 12, 2011. No comments were received from EPA or the public.

Please be advised that, pursuant to SCAQMD Rule 205, the Permit to Construct and Operate shall expire one year from the date of this letter unless an extension of time has been approved in writing by the Executive officer or the construction has been completed before the expiration date.

Please note that this version also reflects changes to Tank 80068 (D610) to remain fixed roof tank and not be modified to internal roof tank, per your request in an e-mail on May 10, 2011. Thus, the P/C-P/O issued to this tank under A/N 476396 on April 22, 2008 is rescinded and the P/O under A/N 470113 has been reinstated.

This Title V permit revision is covered under application A/N 518301. Please review the attached sections carefully.
