This is an existing facility applying for a Title V permit renewal that is engaged in the manufacturing of custom and industrial skylighting. The facility operates four spray booths, open spray gun, an oven, two storage tanks, and other supporting equipment. The spray booths and oven are operated within a permanent total enclosure and the volatile organic compound emissions from the coating and curing operation are controlled by an air pollution control system consisting of carbon adsorption system and a thermal oxidizer.

Comments must be received by October 4, 2010. The AQMD will consider all public comments and may revise the Title V permit in accordance with AQMD rules and regulations.

The public may request the AQMD to conduct a public hearing on any of the proposed permits by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Hamed Mandilawi at the above AQMD address. The AQMD will hold a public hearing if there is evidence that the proposed permits are not correct or are not adequate to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements, and a hearing will likely provide additional information that will affect the drafting and/or issuance of the permits.
