

## NOTICE INVITING WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENTS

NOTICE is hereby given that the Executive Officer/Air Pollution Control Officer of the Bay Area Air Quality Management District has made a preliminary decision to issue a Major Facility Review Permit to the following facility:

Notice is also given that permit conditions have been changed for the purposes of streamlining the conditions and to improve the monitoring.

Major facilities, Phase II Acid Rain facilities, Subject Solid Waste Incinerator facilities, and other facilities designated by US EPA are required to obtain operating permits under Title V of the 1990 Clean Air Act Amendments, the Federal Operating Permit Program and the District's Regulation 2, Rule 6 - Major Facility Review. The permits summarize all air-related requirements that apply to each source of emissions at each facility.

The Executive Officer/Air Pollution Control Officer invites written public comment on the above application and intended action. Comments must be received by 30 days from the date of this publication. Any member of the public may request a public hearing to discuss issuance of a particular permit.

Major Facility Review Permits are also subject to review and approval by US EPA. If US EPA has not objected to a proposed permit and District has not addressed a public comment in a satisfactory manner, the public may petition US EPA, Region IX, Operating Permits Section, at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105, within 60 days after the end of US EPA's review, to reconsider the issuance of the permit.

The proposed Major Facility Review permit and the application are available for public inspection at the District Headquarters, 939 Ellis Street, San Francisco, CA 94109, in the Permit Services Division, 3rd Floor.
