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**NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Clark County Department of Air Quality (DAQ) received an application for a revision to the Authority to Construct permit for a stationary source of regulated air pollutants on February 29, 2011. Supplemental applications were submitted on April 12, 2011, June 6, 2011, and June 28, 2011. DAQ also received an application for an initial Part 70 Operating Permit (Title V) for a stationary source of regulated air pollutants on August 17, 2005. Supplemental applications were submitted on May 4, 2009, and February 2, 2011. The source, Aggregate Industries, is located 1.5 miles West of US I-15, Sloan, NV 89124. The Control Officer has reviewed the applications and determined that the operation of the stationary source can comply with the Clark County Air Quality Regulations (AQR) for all regulated pollutants and should be approved.

This notice announces the 30-day public comment period, commencing Thursday, August 9, 2012, ending on Friday, September 7, 2012, and is being issued pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute 445 and the AQR.

The maximum potential to emit of regulated air pollutants due to the operation of this source will be as follows:

PM<sub>2.5</sub> = 30.77; PM<sub>10</sub> = 83.79; NO<sub>x</sub> = 47.04; CO = 67.16; SO<sub>x</sub> = 21.10; VOC = 12.75; HAP = 3.34

The technical support documents (TSD), which describes the process, discusses compliance with relevant regulations, presents emission calculations, air quality impacts, and the proposed permits are available for public inspection at DAQ, 4701 W Russell Road, Las Vegas, Nevada 89118, telephone (702) 455-5942 or the Clark County website: <http://www.clarkcountynv.gov/Depts/dagem/Pages/PermittingPublicNotices.aspx>. Business hours at DAQ are between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. The TSD, and the proposed permit with enforceable conditions, will be mailed to interested persons upon request. Additional documentation may be requested by contacting Richard D. Beckstead, Permitting Manager, DAQ. Any fees associated with this request will be billed at a cost consistent with DAQ policy and NRS 239.

Any person may submit written or oral comments to the Control Officer at the address given above. All comments must be received by Friday, September 7, 2012 at 4:00 p.m., the close of this 30-day notice. The written comments will be retained and considered prior to the final determination by the Control Officer. A public hearing will be held on the proposed issuance of this permit if a request is made during the public comment period.
