Enclosed are the revised Title Page, Table of Contents, Section D, and Section I of your Title V Facility Permit for the ExxonMobil Pipeline Company's Atwood Terminal located at 1477 N. Jefferson Street, Anaheim, CA. The revised permit reflects the following changes:

Section D: PERMITS TO OPERATE

Section I: PLANS AND SCHEDULES

This Title V revision is covered under A/N 543717 and is considered a "de-minimus significant permit revision" to the Title V permit. The proposed permit was submitted to the EPA for review on November 29, 2012. No comments were received during the EPA 45-day comment period.

In addition, the following administrative changes were made to the Title V permit:

Corrected Permit to Operate No. under A/N 527657 from G18586 to G18589.


Section I: PLANS AND SCHEDULES
