The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) has received and reviewed Title V applications for a De Minimus Significant Permit Revision to the Lunday-Thagard Co. (LTR) Facility Permit. This Title V permit revision meets all the requirements of a De Minimus Significant Permit Revision as defined in Rule 3000(b)(7). LTR is proposing to increase throughput on a loading rack and connect two loading racks to sulfur treatment prior to incineration. The applications are listed in the tables below:
